Notice of incoming lane restrictions.

All,

Per contract documents for the upcoming INDOT Project R-44163 McGalliard Road, E&B Paving is notifying you that construction will begin 4/30 with Construction Engineering staking and will see barrels placed along the project beginning of May. I have attached the work schedule to this email for your reference as well as the Maintenance of traffic prints.

This project runs from Tillotson Ave to Wheeling Ave. Access to businesses and roads will remain open. Any closure of intersections will be completed for short time frames so that paving activity will be completed and opened back up when the mix has cooled enough for traffic to cross.

We will have lighted Vertical Panels running in the center of the road to keep traffic out of the construction zone.

Phase 1 will be outside lanes going Eastbound and Westbound. We will be removing asphalt all the way down to concrete and fixing any issues we find. Once the outside lanes are completed and asphalt is placed back, we will move onto Phase 2.

Phase 2 consists of the inside lanes (Passing Lane) and inside Turn lanes. We will remove all asphalt, see what concrete looks like and build the road back up.
